Children (preschool - 5th grade) are invited to submit one example of recent work. Please label the artwork with the Applicant's name.

Young Artists (grades 6 - 12) and Adults are invited to submit two examples of original artwork, which demonstrates creativity, technique, and presentation.

Digital images of original art are acceptable and preferred. Please label work with the applicant's name.

Scholarship funds are limited. It is likely that not everyone who applies will receive financial assistance. In order to provide the most effective assistance, partial scholarships may be awarded to some applicants.

Scholarships are tuition waivers, which must be used in the designated term and year. Separate applications are required for each term. Scholarships may be applied to one course selection only.
